21		Easy	0.5 miles	Road surface with some grass area.	A frequently used loop trail bordering the road, popular with residents and lined with trees.	Views of downtown and the San Diego Bay. Great for visitors who want to accurately measure and time their exercise.	Information Center / Kiosk
22		Medium	4.4 miles	Dirt trails with some road surfaces.	Experience the native habitat in Florida and Switzer canyons. Partially shaded by oak and eucalyptus trees along the eastern edge of the park.	Florida and Switzer canyons, eastern edge of Balboa Park, Grape Street Park, and the Balboa Park Golf Course. ***	Restroom Facilities
23		Difficult	6.8 miles	Dirt trails, road and sidewalk surfaces.	Takes visitors through natural areas in Florida Canyon and along Balboa Park's eastern border. Returns via gardens and past several museums.	Florida Canyon, the Prado, scenic views of downtown and San Diego Bay, Switzer Canyon and the Balboa Park Golf Course. *** *** CAUTION! - A small section of these trails border the #4 Fairway. Hikers should use caution and be on the lookout for stray golf balls.	Accessible Restroom Picnic Area Off Leash Dog Area Scenic View
